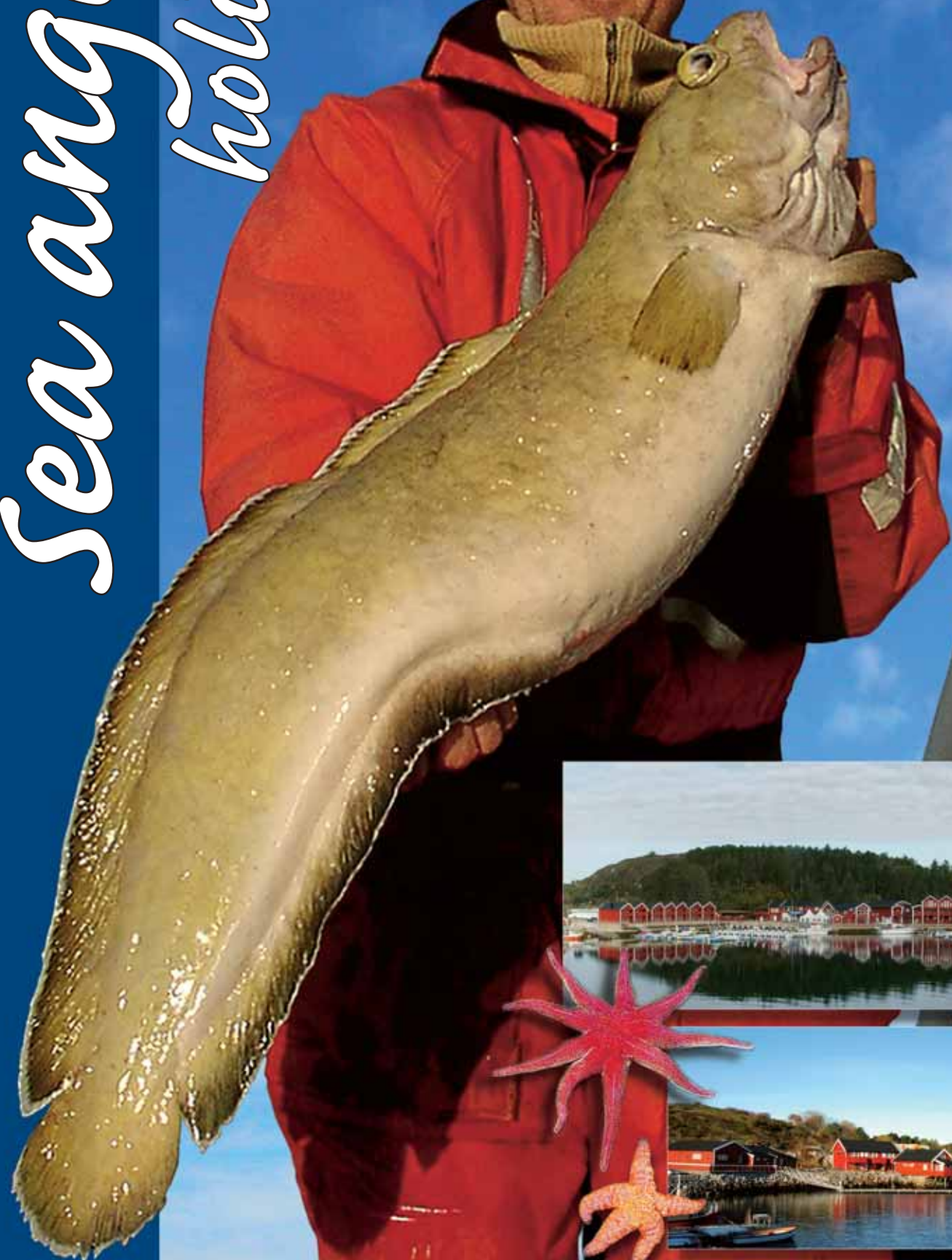

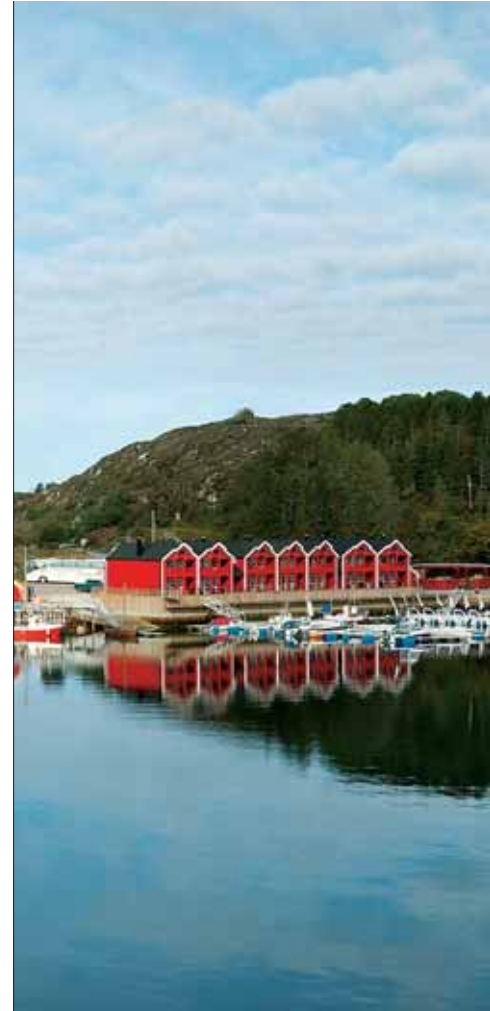

# Angelamfi: Best holiday resort along the coast

Angelamfi Ansnes, previously known as Hitra Havfiskesenter, has always been regarded as a premier address in terms of first-class fishing on Hitra. The entire facility has been totally refurbished and is ready once again to welcome fishing tourists from all over Europe. The standard of both the accommodation and boats is extremely high. In addition to 9 comfortable apartments each with fully-equipped kitchen, dining alcove, lounge with TV (Norwegian and German channels), bedroom(s), bathroom/WC and terrace overlooking the sea, guests also have access to a fish conditioning and cleaning room, cold storage facility, and a laundry room with washing machine and tumble dryer.

The centre has a fully equipped restaurant kitchen, as well as two function rooms each with a capacity for 30-40 guests. These facilities are for leasing to groups who may either bring

along their own chef or order catering from Angelamfi Hitra. The nearest neighbour is Hitra Herregård (manor), where groups can book a pleasant evening meal based on local culinary traditions and the freshest of raw materials. Traditional Sunday dinner at the manor is also popular among locals and tourists alike.

The large waterside terrace is for use by all guests staying at Angelamfi Ansnes. The terrace also has sizeable grills for the guests' convenience; perfect for spending pleasant evenings with fishing enthusiasts from many countries.

The nearest township, Fillan, is just 15 minutes away by car. Fillan has shops, a medical centre and pharmacy, a kiosk with foreign newspapers, a petrol station, off-licence/liquor store (vinmonopol), tourist office, museum, restaurants, public swimming baths and bowling alley.

# Room to relax

Angelamfi Grefsnsvågen is one of the finest holiday and conference centres on the Norwegian coast. Grefsnsvågen is situated on the south-west side of Hitra, facing the ocean and a vast archipelago of islets, holms and skerries. Angelamfi Grefsnsvågen includes 21 well equipped rorbusts and apartments, all with TV (Norwegian and German channels), DVD, ISDN, telephone, fully equipped kitchen, dining alcove, lounge, bedroom(s) and large terrace overlooking the bay. All bedrooms in the rorbusts are en suite. Apartments come with one or two bathrooms depending on the number of beds.

The resort also has a common fish conditioning and cleaning room, an "après-fishing" lounge and a cold storage facility where each accommodation unit has its own deep freezer (220 litres). Guests may use the resort's laundry facilities (washing machine and tumble dryer) by applying to reception, which will also provide assistance with boat hire and fishing guide. The resort's shop (Angelshop) sells some fishing tackle and more.

Angelamfi Grefsnsvågen has a fully equipped dining room seating up to 40 guests, a party tent seating 50 persons and a grilling hut for 12. All these facilities are for rent, with or without a chef/catering staff. Guests also have access to two large grills for use on the jetty.

Kvenvær, a small village with a grocery store (that also sells fishing tackle) and restaurant/pub is just 5 minutes away by car or 15 minutes by boat. The shop also acts as pharmacy, bank and post office. The main community on Hitra, Fillan, is 30 minutes away by car.

# Eldorado for anglers

Located at the entrance to Trondheimsfjorden, Hitra (572 km<sup>2</sup>, 4,100 inhabitants) is the largest Norwegian island south of the Lofotens. The landscape changes from wild, open moorland to thick pine forests and rocky terrain. Hitra has excellent fishing lakes stocked with trout and char, the densest population of deer in Europe, and a rich birdlife with many species of seabirds and a large population of white-tailed eagles.

Hitra is fantastic in glorious summer weather but the nature experience can be equally uplifting when the north wind blows head-on, when snowflakes swirl on frosty cold moonlit nights. The fish bite all year and Angelamfi is full of action summer and winter.

From a single glance at the charts you know what this island has to offer in terms of sea fishing. The sea bed is full of crevices and channels with sheer walls. Geologically varied skerries lay between forests of kelp and sandbanks. This underwater landscape is home to almost all North Atlantic fish species, but Hitra is best known for its numerous deep-sea plateaus providing the perfect habitat for ling, torsk and halibut.

## Sea fishing

The fishing spots near Ansnes are exceptionally good. Besides cod, saithe, red-fish and haddock, Ansnes is the optimum starting point for angling after magnificent ling and torsk since to succeed in this sport you have to have at least 150-250 metres of water beneath you.

Angelamfi Grefsnsvågen lies on the west side of Hitra, on the extremely fish-rich Frøyfjorden. The area is particularly known for its feisty pollack. These waters are also

abundant in other species such as cod, torsk and various oceanic species, and with a bit of luck you might also hook a monkfish or halibut. There are excellent spots for catching red-fish, and specialists in sea angling can test their skills in the famous "Blålanghølen", which is 400 metres deep in parts.



Angelamfi Hitra provides information about all the best fishing areas, and at Grefsnsvågen you can also hire a fishing guide to accompany you.

## Sea fishing trip with m/s "Ansnes"

During the summer we organise two or three sea angling trips a week aboard the fishing vessel m/s "Ansnes". This trip is also for individual paying guests and all bookings are taken by Angelamfi Hitra. These tours start from the neighbouring island of Frøya. Fishing tackle can be hired on board.



## Freshwater fishing

With some 700 freshwater lakes, Hitra is a veritable eldorado for trout fishing. The best times for trout fishing are April/May and September/October + ice fishing in winter. We can provide advice, maps, directions and information about where to obtain fishing permits for the various lakes.



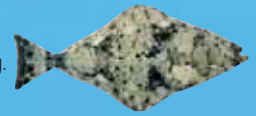
# The most common species of fish

## Atlantic halibut

Size up to 300 cm and 300 kg.  
Season April-December.  
The largest of all the flatfish.  
Firm, white and very tasty meat.



## Monkfish

Size up to 170 cm.  
Season all year.  
From intertidal zone down to 600 metres deep.  
Firm, white and very tasty meat.



## Turbot

Size up to 100 cm.  
Season all year.  
The meat is oily and regarded by many as the best of all edible fishes.



## Torsk

Size up to 110 cm and 15 kg.  
Season all year.  
Found from 50 to 1000 metres deep.  
The meat is firm, white and tastes like lobster.



## Plaice

Size 25-40 cm.  
Season July-December.  
An excellent food fish that is widely used.



## Haddock

Size up to 110 cm.  
Season all year.  
A perfect food fish (fish cakes, -balls and -pudding).



## Saithe

Size up to 120 cm.  
Season all year.  
Can be fried, boiled or grilled, makes exceptionally tasty fish-burgers.



## Ling

Size up to 180 cm.  
Season all year.  
A typical deep-water fish.  
A very tasty fish with fairly course meat texture.



## Pollack

Size up to 130 cm.  
Season all year.  
A good edible fish, though its meat is somewhat dry.



## Mackerel

Size up to 66 cm.  
Season April-November.  
Mackerel can be salted, smoked,



## Wolffish

Size up to 125 cm.  
Season all year.  
Wolffish or catfish is considered very tasty.



## Redfish

Size up to 100 cm and 15 kg.  
Season all year.  
With oily meat that stays, but which tastes best salted.



## Cod

Size up to 180 cm and 55 kg.  
Season: Norwegian arctic cod (skrei) January-April.  
Capelin cod April-June.  
Coastal cod all year.  
Cod is processed to produce stockfish and clipfish. Fresh, frozen, filleted, smoked and salted cod are important products.  
By-products include cod liver oil and roe.  
One of the best food fishes on the market, can be boiled, grilled or deep fried in batter.



## Fresh water trout

Size 15-80 cm, usually 2-3 kg, can grow up to 10 kg.  
Season April/May, September/October and ice fishing.  
Trout is often salt-cured or smoked. It can also be boiled or grilled.



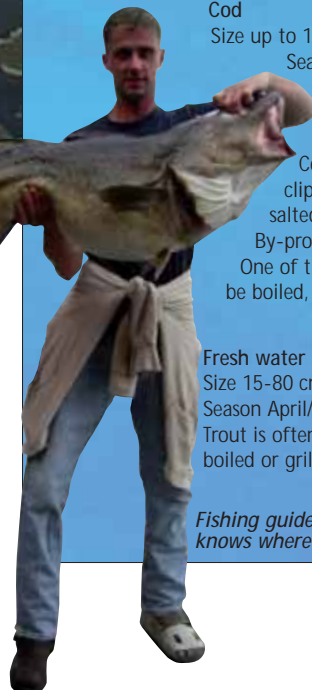

# Great nature experiences – on land and sea



Bathing facilities



**A**dditional activities for those who want a fishing holiday with something extra...

### Sea rafting

We use a 24.5 feet Zodiac Hurricane powered by 2 x 175 HP Evinrude engines. Top speed: 50 knots. 10 – 12 persons per trip. Fun, exciting and offering a wild nature experience out towards the Atlantic Ocean. Angelamfi provides floating suits.

### Eldorado for divers

The waters off Grefsnesvågen and Ansnes are a paradise for scuba divers. One of the staff at Angelamfi Hitra is an experienced diver and is always ready to act as skipper and guide to the most interesting diving spots. Grefsnesvågen has diving equipment (not suits) for hire, air tanks and a compressor. Divers staying at Ansnes can fill their tanks at Grefsnesvågen but must supply all other equipment themselves.

### Outdoor bathing facility

Angelamfi Grefsnesvågen has a heated, outdoor bathing facility with sauna, whirlpool and hot-tub – all at the disposal of our guests. Here you can revive body and soul (and take in the views) summer and winter. In fact, it is even more invigorating when the air temperature is low.

### Other activities

Swimming in the sea and lakes, fell walking, golf, riding, water skiing, tube towing, cycle tours (cycle hire at Grefsnesvågen), mini-golf, darts (at Grefsnesvågen).

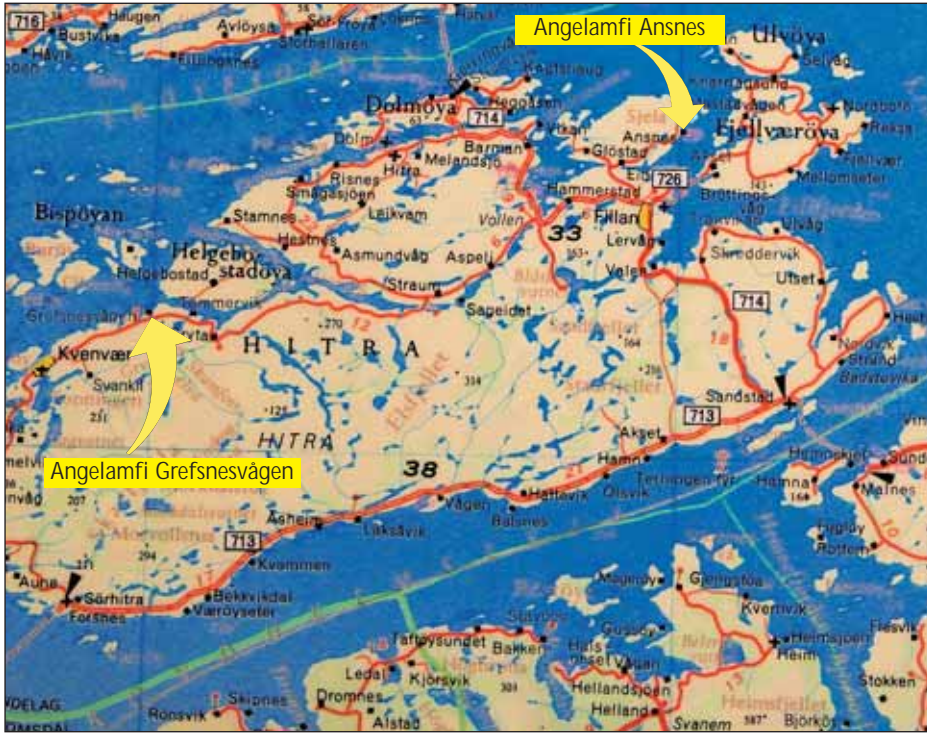
## Uttern Exclusive 5602

1 boat.  
Length 5,5 m, beam 2,2 m.  
Fuel tank capacity 70 litres, 50 HP.  
Combined chart plotter, echo sounder, GPS.  
Max. 6 persons.



## Coastal jeep Midwest

30 boats.  
Length 5,2 m, beam 2,1 m. Fuel tank capacity 2 x 25 litres.  
25 of the boats have 25 HP engines, 5 have 40 HP engines.  
Echo sounder, GPS for hire.  
Max. 4 persons.  
1 jeep with 25 HP engine per living unit is included in the price of accommodation with stays of 1 week or more.



# Travelling to Angelamfi Hitra

If you are travelling by car or bus from Oslo, follow route E18 out of the city. Then you choose route E6 towards Trondheim. Stay on this route until you reach Klett, just before Trondheim.

At Klett, choose E39. Follow E39 to Orkanger. Just before the gas station, after having passed Orkanger, turn right following the sign to Hitra/Agdenes. After appr. 5 minutes, turn left still following the sign to Hitra. Continue straight ahead following the signs until you have passed the tunnel between the main land and Hitra.

If you are going to *Ansnes* follow the main road at Hitra. You pass Fillan, and about 10 minutes later you will see the sign to Ansnes.

To get to *Grefsnsvågen*, follow the main road to and through Fillan. Appr. 15 minutes after passing Fillan, turn left at the sign to Kvenvær. Then go straight ahead for appr. 20 minutes until you see the Grefsnsvågen sign just before you arrive at Kvenvær.

The journey from Trondheim (appr. 120 km) takes about 2,5 hours by car or by boat (Kystekspresen from Trondheim or Kristiansund, several departures each day). The boat arrives at Sandstad at Hitra, and from there Angelamfi Hitra might arrange pick up by taxi or bus.

It is also possible to arrange helicopter transport from Værnes Airport Trondheim direct to the helipad at Angelamfi Hitra, Grefsnsvågen.
